## A Day On Safari

Guests are invited to rise early and fuel up with coffee, tea and light snacks before the early morning game drive.

As the sun rises over the horizon, rangers and trackers head out with guests into the bush to spot and observe wildlife. Guests will ride on the same vehicle for the duration of their stay so they develop a rapport and history with their rangers and trackers.

Return from game drive for a delicious hot breakfast.

Enjoy the remainder of the morning at leisure to enjoy the camp's spa and gym facilities and swimming pool or use the time to read, write post cards, gaze out over the savannah or relax under the sun.

Amenities of the gym and massage service rejuvenate while private verandahs overlooking the bush offer moments for quiet contemplation and intimate family time.
