Arrival Day: Lima

Make a stop in Dédalo Staged in an old refurbished house in Barranco, a block away from the sea, it offers Peruvian non-traditional workmanship at its best. Finally, visit Larco Mar, a nice cliffside park with fountains for entertainment and open-air shopping of great samples of Peruvian alpaca textiles, art, handicrafts and books.

Browse the museum's display of 45,000 archaeological objects considered to be pre-Columbian art icons around the world. Everything is chronologically exhibited in impressive galleries showing the continuous development of 3,000 years of Peru's pre-Columbian history.

Take pleasure in its beautiful gardens, located inside a unique viceroyalty mansion dating back to the XVIII century and appreciate the museum's finest old Peruvian gold and silver collection as well one of the most famous erotic art collections.

Larco Herrera Museum is also renowned for its famous and fascinating erotic pottery collection which is on display in the separate "Erotic Hall", depicting sexual practices of several Peruvian cultures. At the end of the services you will be transported to your hotel

Day 6 Cusco City: Lima - Cusco City - Local Immersion into Peruvean Life

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and meet your private English speaking driver in the lobby of your hotel for your transfer to the airport. Meet your flight to Cusco City.

Upon arrival in Cusco City, you will be met by your private English speaking driver. After collecting your luggage walk through the doors and look for a sign with your name. You will be transferred to your hotel at Sacred Valley.

Upon arrival at the hotel, you will be welcomed with a VIP check-in experience. Your luggage will be managed and delivered to your accommodation

After you have settled in, you will meet your private driver in the lobby of your hotel for your Private home luncheon experience.

Lunch at Hacienda Huayoccari, a beautiful ranch built in the Fifties by one of the most prestigious families in Cusco:landowners and art collectors. It is located 1.5 miles uphill from the main Sacred Valley road.



Huayoccari is a private home. It provides beautiful surroundings, amazing garden and views, antiques and folk art throughout and delicious food. The house is lived-in by its owners and receives guests to private luncheons by appointment only.





After yoru visit to the Hacienda, you will continue on with an Excursion to Pisac Ruins & Market (Alternatives available: Chinchero, Pisac Ruins, Pisac Market or Maras & Moray).

Visit the Pisac mountaintop complex including overlooks, terraces and the main temple, located next to the town of Pisac. It is known for its small, polished stones that fit perfectly together. In the main ruins, you will find temples of the sun, moon, rain, rainbow, and stars, as well as a few Inca crosses rising from the ground.

Among the most important buildings in the area are *Pisaca*, which is a fine curving wall, the *Intihuatana* group of temples, and the military area, called "Q' *Allaqasa*". Exploring these ruins means walking a path, which snakes its way along the hillsides east of the Sacred Valley.

Visit Pisac village and its traditional market. The small Main Square is filled wall-to-wall with stalls selling the full range of Peruvian handicrafts: alpaca sweaters and mittens, carved gourds or "mates burilados", ceramics, felt hats, musical instruments, paintings, antiques, a huge variety of trinkets, and, most of all, weavings and jewelry.

Even if you are not buying, the café balconies overlooking the square offer you superb people-watching opportunities. Traditionally, people of the highlands come down to exchange their produce such as vegetables, weavings and pottery, for essentials such as salt, sugar and rice in a trade called "trueque".



You can also visit the church and a small interesting museum.





After the tours you will be returned to your hotel.

Day 7 Sacred Valley: Cusco City - Sacred Valley - Macchu Picchu

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast meet your private English-speaking driver and professional local guide in the lobby of your hotel for your trip up to the highest point in Cusco City and your Biking Adventure.

This activity takes you to visit the highlands of the city of Cusco. You will be able to enjoy the countryside and view the historic city from above. The bikes will be tested, and you will have a short instruction and safety talk regarding the bike ride. Helmets and gloves must be worn at all times during the bike ride.

According to the level of experience of the bikers, you can choose a trip descending on a paved road or down hill on dirt roads and single tracks. These mountain bike descents can be personalized depending on the skills and experience of the guests.







After the Mountain Biking Experience, you will enjoy Lunch in the Sacred Valley. In Wayra Restaurant's terrace, you will taste the delights of the Valley on the table. While you savor the delectable meal you will be entertained with the performance of the Peruvian step horse "Caballo de Paso" and the typical coast dance "Marinera" are combined.





After the tours you will be returned to your hotel.

Day 8 Sacred Valley: Excursion to Maras & Moray

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast meet your private English-speaking driver guide in the lobby of your hotel for your **Excursion to Maras & Moray** (Alternatives available: Chinchero, Pisac Ruins, Pisac Market, Pisac Ruins & Market or Ollantaytambo).

Enjoy a private guided excursion through the sites of Maras and Moray. En route, witness some of the best sites in the valley.

First, stop at the ancient salt mines, nearby the town of Maras, which can be seen from an old chapel just above. Second, visit the huge circular agricultural terraces at Moray built by the Incas in natural sinkholes on a limestone plateau overlooking the Urubamba Valley. It has been suggested that they have a cosmological meaning; however, the Incas are thought to have used them as a kind of crop—laboratory to determine the optimal conditions of each species.





Enjoy a gourmet outdoor lunch.





After lunch you will be returned to your hotel.



You will check out of your hotel and meet your private English-speaking driver in the lobby of your hotel for your transfer to the Ollantaytambo Train Station.

Departure from Ollantaytambo train station to Machu Picchu by the First Class train service of Inca Rail.

The Vistadome trains have beautiful panoramic windows offering unsurpassed scenic views and photographic opportunities as you enter the Inca's territory in search for Machu Picchu Citadel. With glass surrounding them on all sides, passengers feel as if they are part of Peru's remarkable landscape.

Entertainment on board, snacks and hot and cold refreshments are included on the journey.

Arrival in Aguas Calientes train station.





There will be a Reception at the train station by the hotel's representatives followed by a short walk and assistance to Inkaterra Machu Picchu.





Evening at leisure to relax or enjoy some of the hotel's most charming attractions that include the reading room, the wall in the main dining room displaying scores of pre-



Columbian artifacts, the lounge's crackling fireplaces, and the Andean sauna, an igloo made from indigenous bamboo and fresh eucalyptus leaves, in the UNU Spa (Prices for services at the UNU Spa are available at the front desk of the Hotel).

Suggested Excursions: Bird-watching walk, Nature trail, Twilight walk, Orchid Tour, Organic Tea Processing and Evening Nature Shows.

Dinner "a la carte" at the Main Restaurant; This restaurant, brags adjacent terraces which were built as a large glass house with an exceptional view of the Urubamba River and the surrounding green mountains.

Overnight at Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel

Day 9 Sacred Valley: Macchu Picchu - Cusco City

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast meet your private English-speaking driver and guide n the lobby of your hotel for your trip up to Machu Picchu.

Huayna Picchu & Machu Picchu Citadel Excursion. (Options available: Machu Picchu, Apu Machu Picchu, Mandor Waterfalls or Putukusi Mountain).

Your experience will begin after a 30-minute bus ride to the mystical Machu Picchu Citadel. (8000 ft. – 2432 m.a.s.l.). Once there, climb the mystical Huayna Picchu Mountain in order to see the ruins at the top.

There are 2 entrance opportunities dependent on availability; 7am or 10am. We will select the 7am entrance time unless otherwise requested. This hike lasts approximately 2 hours at a slow pace. Then, explore the Machu Picchu citadel accompanied by a certified English-speaking guide.

Explore the enigmatic citadel of Machu Picchu accompanied with your guide. Your expert guide will lead you through the site, providing archaeological and historical information on key areas of interest, including Intihuatana (the Sun Dial), the Sacred Plaza and the Temple of the Sun. Afterwards take some leisure time before returning by bus to Aguas Calientes.







After the excursion, enjoy lunch at *Tinkuy* Restaurant at the Sanctuary Lodge and afterwards take some leisure time before returning by bus to Aguas Calientes.





Departure at 17:50 hrs from Aguas Calientes train station to Poroy in Cusco by the Hiram Bingham train service.

The Hiram Bingham train is the most luxurious way to journey between Cusco and Machu Picchu. It is named after the explorer who discovered the fascinating remains of the Inca citadel, Machu Picchu on July 23rd 1911. The carriages are painted a distinctive blue and gold while interiors are luxurious, warm and inviting with elegant decoration in the style of the 1920's Pullman trains.

Cocktails and a gourmet dinner are served on the return to Cusco.

Arrival in Poroy train station in Cusco at 21:16 hrs

Day 10 Cusco: Inkaterra - Cusco

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast meet your private English-speaking driver and guide in the lobby of your hotel for your experiences in this area today.

Visit the main ruins in the outskirts of the city. Sacsayhuaman, which in Quechua means "satisfied falcon", is the most impressive ruin close to the city. It is a walled complex of religious and military significance. Thought to be a hunting lodge, Puca Pucará, which means "red fort" in Quechua, is a rock structure which looks pink in some lights. It is composed of several lower residential chambers, storerooms and an upper esplanade with great views.

Later visit Quenko, which means "zigzag" in Quechua, and consists of a large limestone structure riddled with niches, steps and carving, including zigzagging channels which gave the site its name. Finally, visit Tambomachay (Cavern Lodge), commonly referred to as the "Baños del Inca" or Inca baths. Tambomachay was an Incan site for ritual bathing. The excellent quality of the stonework suggests that its use was restricted to the higher nobility, who probably only used the baths on ceremonial occasions.







Lunch "a la carte" at Incanto Restaurant, located a few meters of the Main Square on the architectonic vestiges of the old Hatun Kancha or Inka Yupanqui's palace. Welcoming and contemporary, its varied menu offers Italian food, pasta and specialties from the grill cooked with an original touch and using Peruvian ingredients.





Dinner at MAP Café restaurant, an area devoted to the best of Peruvian contemporary haute cuisine. Stands out for its integrative cuisine that combines the best of the Andes, getting modern preparations. Its infrastructure is a minimalist glass structure that complements the charming patio of the colonial house.







Day 11 Cusco: Cusco – Juliaca – Puno (Lake Titicaca)

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and meet your private English-speaking driver and guide n the lobby of your hotel for your transfer to the Cusco Airport for your departure to Juliaca Alrport.

You will be met and Welcomed at *Juliaca* Airport by our Guest Services Representative and transfer by car to Titilaka. (*Approximate time of travel: 1 hour and 45 minutes*). Upon arrival at the hotel, proceed with your check in. Rest and enjoy the scenery as you acclimatize.





Enjoy sunset cocktails from the panoramic terraces overlooking the lake.

Dinner is served in the main dining room.



After Dinner, you may luxuriate in your appointed suite or join other guests and interpreters to talk about your highlands experience.

Overnight at your luxurious lake-view suite at Titilaka.

Day 12 Lake Titicaca: Lake Titicaca

Breakfast in your hotel. After rising at the hour that suits you, enjoy breakfast in bed or in the lake-view dining room, with choices of a variety of fresh fruit, local cereals and products, or if you wish, join the morning excursion.





Excursion to Taquile Island. (Alternatives available: Uros floating islands, Sillustani, Mountain biking to Inca Anatawi and Perka).

Taquile is considered the most interesting island on the Peruvian side of Lake Titicaca, located in front of the *Chucuito* Peninsula. The *Taquile* people of *Quechua* origin, as opposed to the majority of region's locals who are of *Aymara* origin, live at 13,000 feet above sea level.

You may get to know their way of life and experiences. As formerly part of the Inca Empire, you may also see some archaeological remains in the island, such as stone quarters, doors, windows and pathways on the peak of its mountain, where you can also view the impressive panorama of Lake Titicaca and the snow covered mountains of *Cordillera Real*.

Due to the thermal effect of the lake on the weather which provides more oxygen to the atmosphere and warmer temperatures, the island offers a favorable micro-climate for agriculture, producing crops which don't normally grow at these altitudes.



As you walk around the island, you will see local men knitting outdoors, one of the finest knitted handicrafts in Peru.

You will return to the hotel for lunch and siesta time.

After Lunch, Excursion to Socca beach. (Alternatives available: Inca Anatawi, Rowing through the reeds, Bird watching and Titilaka arch).

Travel east of the lodge-refuge, to visit the rustic town community of *Socca*, between wetlands and farms where you can appreciate the agricultural practices of the locals and know the customs. Enjoy the magnificent scenery around the highest navigable lake of the world; watch the idyllic sunset and the first stars coming out as night sets in. Upon your arrival to the hotel enjoy the intense sunset. Enjoy cocktails and dinner at the main restaurant.

Day 13 Lake Titicaca - Lima

Breakfast in your hotel.

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and meet your private English-speaking driver in the lobby of your hotel. You will be transferred to Juliaca airport where you will be assisted by our Guest Services Representative prior to your flight to Lima.
