14 Day Italy Itinerary: Rome - Florence - Tuscany - Rome



Day 1 Arrival Italy: US - Rome

Upon arrival at Rome Fiumicino Airport, enjoy a comfortable and efficient luxury VIP meet and greet service. Beginning from the aircraft, escorting you right to your waiting driver for a transfer to your hotel (TBD).

- You will be met at the aircraft with a name sign, at this point you will be escorted through immigration.
- Your assistant will be on hand to collect all your baggage off the carousel and escort you curbside to meet your English-speaking Driver for a transfer to hotel The First.
- This service includes full assistance in case of flight delays, cancellation or passenger delay and special needs. (Assistant at disposal for 1 hour)
- Please note that porterage service is not included however if you wish
- you may request this locally and pay for it directly to the porters.
- Transfer to the hotel The First by private English- speaking Driver

Upon arrival at the hotel, The First Hotel, where you have a Jacuzzi Suite with Terrace reserved for 4 nights. Breakfast, services and taxes included. You will be met by the Concierge who will welcome you to Rome with a private and immediate VIP check-in experience. Your luggage will be managed and delivered to your accommodation.

After check-in, you are at leisure to settle into your suite and relax a bit.




This evening, we experience all the sights that this very special area has to offer... The Spanish steps, Fountain of the Barcaccia, Building of the Propaganda Fide, the Trevi Fountain, Virgo Water Aqueduct. We will walk on the Via del Corso (longest road of Rome), reaching the political center of Italy with the Palazzo Montecitorio, House of the



Deputies, Palazzo Chigi (office of the Prime Minister), the famous Obelisk used inside the Pantheon and the best preserved Roman temple.

We end our tour in Navona Square where we admire the baroque Fountain of the Four Rivers of Gianlorenzo Bernini. This is an excellent area then to stop for a meal at one of the many open air bars/restaurants and pizzerias. (Tour duration: 3 hours)









8.00 pm – Dinner Reservation Tre Scalini restaurant – (payment direct to the restaurant at time of service.)

This is a great restaurant in superb location on the Piazza Navona which is enjoyed by locals and visitors alike. A warm welcome always awaits you as does a great selection of National and local Roman dishes.

The menu is varied, as is the wine list, and you are just as welcome here whether choosing the Ristorante Tre Scalini for a leisurely aperitif as you are should you wish to enjoy a special meal. The atmosphere is smart.

9.00am: Meet your English-speaking Driver & Professional Local Guide in the lobby of the hotel, to begin a very special introduction to the amazing highlights of Imperial Rome.







This mix of driving and walking tours, is a great way to see and enjoy the highlights of Imperial Rome. On this tour we will visit the valley of the Roman Forum. We see the inside of the Senate and the inside of the Basilica of Constantine.





From the outside we will see the other ruins (temples, basilicas, Reggia, etc.). We will walk the Via Sacra to the Arch of Tito and enjoy the Colosseum both externally and from the inside.

We'll walk to the palatine hill to visit the ruins of the imperial palaces and its small museum.

We then head to the Basilica of St. Peter in Chains to see the Holy Chains of St. Peter and the Moses carved by Michelangelo! Not to mention the Vittoriano (otherwise known as the Wedding Cake). The tour ends with a panoramic drive past Circus Maximus, Aventino Hill nd the Palatino Hill. (Tour duration: 4 hours)

Entrances to Colosseum included.











After the morning tour, you will enjoy lunch on your own.

Your guide will offer recommendations for dining in the area. (typically on full day tours, you would invite your driver and guide to dine with you, at your expense.

However, they do not expect this and are perfectly happy to have lunch on their own and meet you after lunch to continue your

touring.)

Important things to know about visiting the Vatican: Bags, backpacks, umbrellas

- The cloakroom staff will accept from the visitors their bags and personal belongings
 - (ir-respective of the form, material or dimension of the object), with the exception of clothing items, hats, portable umbrellas.
- It is obligatory to deposit in the cloakroom suitcases, backpacks and containers with dimensions larger than cm 40 x 35 x 15.



- It is obligatory to deposit in the cloakroom bags and bag packs which are cumbersome, except those small-sized, that carried on shoulder, don't jut out by 15 cm from the body's shape in its highest point.
- It is obligatory to deposit in the cloakroom any umbrella with a spike tip, umbrellas
 - of medium and large size, walking sticks (except those required by disabled visitors to facilitate their movement), tripods for cameras and video cameras, signage of any kind (except signs used by official guides for their identification).
- It is obligatory to deposit in the cloakroom knives, scissors, any tools that could be harmful to other persons or damage works of art in the Museums.
- It is not possible to deposit in the cloakroom, firearms of any kind or other dangerous objects. It is strictly forbidden to enter the Museums with any kind of weapon.
- Access to the Museums by armed visitors is not permitted. No exception to this
 rule is made for visitors holding a firearm permit, or if the weapon forms part of a
 uniform (police, military or others).

Day 3 Italy: Rome - Tivoli





Breakfast at Hotel - at leisure.







9.30am: Meet your English-speaking Driver & Professional Local Guide in the lobby of the hotel, to begin a wonderful introduction to the beautiful town of Tivoli and the amazing gardens of the Villas Adriana and D'Este.

Our tour begins by taking us out of Rome in a North East direction to the village of Tivoli which is located around 45 minutes driving time from Rome.

Tivoli is famous for the quarries of Travertine Stone (which is the stone always used in Rome as for the Colosseum and St. Peters Square), it's also been known as a popular summer resort since the days of the Roman Republic. The main attractions of Tivoli were its clean air and beautiful situation on the slopes of the Tiburtini hills, its healthy sulphur springs and the waterfalls which Emperor Augustus insisted cured his insomnia.



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Tivoli is also famous for the Renaissance Villa D'Este built by a cardinal to be his residence. The villa, which occupies the site of an old Benedictine convent, has interesting decorations on the walls but the main attraction is the park with the many fountains. (Note: There are many steps to go down hill and there is no elevator to come back up). From the panoramic terrace we can admire the view of the valley of Rome.

A few miles from the inhabited center of Tivoli there is the huge territory of the Villa of the Emperor Hadrian. Here, we visit all the different buildings designed for the Emperor or by the Emperor himself, thermal baths, monumental squares, fountains and statues just for the recreation of the powerful Hadrian. (Tour duration: 5 hours)

Entrances to Villa Adriana and villa d'Este included.

Lunch is on your own today. Your guide will recommend options for dining in Tivoli.







2:30pm: You will be returned to your hotel, where you will be at leisure for the remainder of the day, until early evening.

Enjoy the areas of Frascati and Castelgandolfo but also stop at some of the beautiful smaller towns of the area, meet the local people and learn all about their way of life, culture and much more as you explore this very unique area. (Tour duration: 4 hours)









You will be returned to your hotel after the tour, where you will be at leisure to relax in the hotel, enjoy the spa, or explore a little of Rome on your own.

This leisurely transfer with our local expert Driver will take us on a pleasant journey north through the heart of Lazio and Tuscany to the beautiful town of Orvieto which is perched on a 300 metres plateau overlooking the vineyard spotted plain below – many visitors flock to Orvieto to admire the beautiful Duomo here, which is said to be one of Italy's greatest cathedrals – we think you will be blown away by its breathtaking façade.

Lunch in Orvieto on your own. Your Guide will recommend dining options in the area.

Following a couple of hours to enjoy admiring the Duomo and the other highlights of Orvieto we will continue our journey north to the heart of Florence (total transfer duration – 7 Hours: time n Orvieto 3 Hours)











Upon arrival in Florence, you will be delivered to your hotel for check-in.

Upon arrival at the Hotel Villa Medici, you will be met by the concierge for a VIP welcome and check-in experience. Your luggage will be managed and delivered to your accommodation. You have a double Deluxe Penthouse room reserved for 7 nights. Breakfast, services and taxes included.



After check-in, you will be at leisure to relax in the hotel.

Florence is a vast and beautiful monument to the Renaissance, the artistic and cultural reawakening of the 15th century. Writers such as Dante, Petrach and Machiavelli contributed to its proud literary heritage, but it was the paintings and sculptures of artists such as Botticelli, Michelangelo and Donatello that turned the city into one of the world's greatest artistic capitals.











Day 6 Italy: Florence

9.00am: Meet your English-speaking Driver & Professional Local Guide in Hotel Villa Medici and enjoy the 'Complete' Introduction to the Highlights of Florence.

The best way to see Florence in a day! Part of this tour is with a private car and driver at your disposal for three hours to see the highlights of the city.







We stop at the Academy of Fine Arts, to see the David and other sculptures by Michelangelo.

We also visit Santa Croce, the Franciscan church where Michelangelo is buried, along with Galileo, Rossini and Machiavelli. Here are also splendid works of Giotto, Donatello and Brunelleschi.

Also, enjoy the splendid views from the hills above town as we stop up at San Miniato al













At the end of the three hours, our driver will leave us near the Signoria Square.

Here, we shall have a short break, perhaps at the fashionable Cafe Rivoire, before continuing with a tour of the city which we have specially customized with this added touch – Visit some fascinating workshops where it is possible to watch the masters creating beautiful handmade pieces. Semi-previous inlaid stone, Florentine colored paper, leather craftsman, gold and bronze workers, painters of miniatures, framemakers, all of these creations made using the same tools and techniques of the past.



The artisans of Florence have given the city a very unique reputation and character which is still upheld to this day.

9:00am: Chef Stefania will meet you to the Mercato Centrale (the historical Florence food market) to buy the ingredients for the lesson, an occasion to learn a lot about Italian food traditions and curiosities.

10:00am: You will transfer to Chef Stefania's home for a VIP Exclusive Cooking Class. She will guide you through some simple steps to make a great "five courses meal". The following is just an example:

- Schiacciata
- Fresh homemade ravioli with ricotta and pesto
- Spezzatino con patate (beef stew tuscan style)
- Chicken with black olives
- Chocolate and red wine cake

This very special experience begins with a visit to the vineyards and wine cellars where this noble family produces their own Chianti wines and extra-virgin olive oil.

This magnificent estate is located in the middle of the Chianti hills and when the weather is good, from the top of the estate you can enjoy

a breathtaking view of Siena.

During our visit, Nicolò will introduce us to the fascinating process of caring for and harvesting the grapes and producing the family's wines as well sharing wonderful stories about the family themselves.

Following the visit of Fattoria Montereggioni we will head to the exquisite colonial house, Il Colli of the Bindi Sergardi family, for a very typical Tuscan lunch together with Nicolò's wife and his daughter Alessandra who knows all there is to know about wine and oils. For a truly exclusive, fun and original first hand glimpse into the people, their lives and lifestyle behind some of Italy's most prized gastronomic delights; this tour is an absolute must. (Tour duration: 4.5 hours).

Our walk takes us over the Ponte Vecchio to the south side of the Arno River, through the streets of a lesser-known part of Florence. Here, traditions survive. The workshops, small boutiques and little squares, make this one of the most delightful quarters of the city.





The Palazzo Pitti, with its extensive gardens behind, is an impressive complex, housing an immense collection of art in several different museums. In 1550, it became the main residence of the Grand-dukes, successively, of the Austrian rulers, of Napoleon's sister, Elisa and later, of the first King of Italy during that brief period when Florence was capital of the newly formed Kingdom.











The apartments, with their rich decoration, reflect the taste of the various periods. For the Medici, it was an impressive stage for a family that had quickly risen from mere merchants to Grand-dukes, with an aspiration to become Kings of Tuscany.

The Medici's residence, with its opulent interiors, superlative collections of masterpieces and gardens full of marvels, will be inspiration for the French kings at Versailles and Fontainebleau. Our visit to the Palatine Gallery takes us through lavish settings with masterpieces of Renaissance painters: such as Raphael, Titian, Rubens. There are beautiful furnishings and delightful views out over the gardens directly behind the palace. (Tour duration-4 hours)

• Entrances to Palatine Gallery and Boboli Gardens included.

After your morning tour, you will be returned to your hotel, where you are at leisure for the remainder of the day until dinner.



8.00pm: Dinner Reservation at Enoteca Pinchiorri restaurant. (Payment to be made direct to the restaurant at time of service)

Boasting one of the best wine cellars in Europe, it is located on the ground floor of 15th century Palazzo Ciofi Jacometti. Cuisine is a mixture of traditional Tuscan, Italian with modern concept. This is one of the most expensive restaurants in Italy, but often described as one of its finest.

This tour will take us west of Florence to visit and enjoy and understand 2 of Tuscany's most beautiful towns that are very near to each other in distance yet very, very different. The first stop today is Lucca – easily one of Tuscany's most beautiful and interesting towns.



Surrounded by a medieval wall which you may want to walk or cycle around to get a great view of the entire historical city, Lucca has a very attractive historical center. It is full of beautiful palaces with the wrought iron railings on the balconies, tiny nooks and crannies, small stores where many artisans can be found and attractive corners well worth discovering.





After time exploring Lucca, you will enjoy lunch here as the restaurants in Lucca are particularly good and varied.

After lunch, you will head towards the Sea and the town of Pisa.



While known by many people for the famous Leaning Tower you may be surprised to learn and enjoy, following a great introduction by your Local Expert Driver. The Field of Miracles where the Duomo and Baptistry are also located, just a stone's throw away from the Leaning Tower.





Just as for Lucca, prior to arrival in Pisa your Local Expert Driver will tell you all about Pisa, its amazing history, its beautiful monuments and buildings as well as its people. From Pisa, return directly to Florence (Tour duration: 8 hours).

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Fiesole boasts Etruscan walls, remains of a temple and a Roman bath. There is also an impressive Roman theatre, still in use today.





It is possible to see the of the level of civilization from the Etruscan, through the Roman to the Dark Ages. The views to the olive-clad hills north are stunning. Inside the little museum are some exceptional treasures, including beautiful ceramics. Learn more about the intriguing Etruscans that inhabited Fiesole, before the arrival of the Romans.



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The lovely grounds of Villa Gamberaia can be found outside the village of Settignano. This garden is truly one of the most magical places in the world, where, in an astonishingly small space, yet without the sense of overcrowding, the typical elements of the old Italian garden come together.





Enjoy the different corners and views across the valley while learning about the Renaissance garden, the Tuscan villa and the lifestyle of its inhabitants.

Our drive takes us also to the San Miniato, a rare example of the Romanesque style of a thousand years ago. This Romanesque jewel boasts a lovely façade, beautiful inlaid floors, mosaic apse, as well as an interesting collection of frescoes.



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Most afternoons, it is possible to hear the Gregorian chant of the Olivetan monks. From here there is a spectacular view of the city. (Tour duration: 4 hours)

On arrival in Siena you will enjoy a wonderful introduction to the Highlights of this typically Tuscan Town.

Siena is a Medieval town completely surrounded by fourteenth century walls. The tour starts with a visit of the old town financial area: Palaces built by rich merchants and bankers, including the headquarters of the oldest bank in Europe. From here we cross the main square "Il Campo", where the Palio horserace still takes place after many centuries, this is Italy's loveliest piazza which occupies the site of the old Roman Forum, and for much of Siena's early history was the city's principal marketplace.





From the Piazza we head to the highest point of the town to visit the Duomo which is one of Italy's greatest cathedrals (1136 – 1382). The cathedral is a spectacular mixture of sculpture, paintings and Pian influenced Romanesque – Gothic architecture. Inside the Cathedral you can enjoy masterpieces by Nicola and Giovanni Pisano, Donatello, Michelangelo and Bernini.
