One of the Christmas markets along the Ring is the famous Christkindlmarkt on the Rathausplatz (the square in front of town hall). It's usually packed, but the small surrounding park is worth an evening walk, too.



### See Belvedere At Night:

The Belvedere Palace Christmas Market runs all the way up to Christmas Eve and is one of the newest and least commercial markets held across the city.

This makes it a much more intimate affair than the bigger markets outside the Rathaus and the Schönbrunn Palace. Held in front of the magnificent Belvedere Palace—a wondrous baroque pile built at the start of the 18th century for Prince Eugene of Savoy as a

summer residence that is now in south-east central Vienna—the facade of the Palace is lit up and there are stalls selling traditional handicraft items, Austrian food and drinks, and Christmas decorations.

Shop - Eat - Sightsee and Explore - "Oh what Fun..."





A fine idea for that steaming mug of something warm is Weihnachtspunsch (Christmas punch): it keeps the chill at bay on a cold winter's evening. The markets serve their punch in collectible mugs, and each market has a unique design. You pay a deposit when you order, so you can keep the mug and lose the deposit (which is perfectly fine).

#### VISIT A ROAST CHESTNUT STAND

Every market has one. And just about every street corner in winter, too: a "Maronistand" selling roasted potato snacks and roast chestnuts.



It's an experience shared with generations before you. You can imagine medieval children blowing on their fingers to keep them cool after picking open a hot chestnut. Now you can follow in their footsteps.

### **ENJOY A SAUSAGE**

You can eat a sausage at one of Vienna's many sausage stands any time of year. But they come into their own in winter.

VISIT THE NATIVITY SCENES IN ST. PETER'S CHURCH

Peterskirche (St. Peter's church) is a tumult of decorative Baroque opulence, with barely a brick that hasn't been touched by an artist's or sculptor's hand.

It's quite beautiful inside and even more atmospheric during Advent when it hosts an exhibition of nativity scenes.



### LISTEN TO AN ADVENT CONCERT

And for even more advent atmosphere, take in a choir recital or advent concert. Top venues include Stephansdom (St.Stephen's cathedral), the Peterskirche, and the Minoritenkirche (an Italian church).

The Schönbrunn Palace has been a venue for classical music since the days of the Habsburg rule and was where the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra's had their very first performance. The annual Christmas and New Year concert features a wonderfully Viennese repertoire, with music from Austrian home-grown favorites Mozart and Strauss, performed in the gloriously imperial setting of the Schönbrunn Orangery.

Your evening includes a "VIP" ticket, which includes a three-course dinner and glass of champagne during the intermission of the concert.

Afternoon: Imperial Treasury of Vienna and the Kunst historisches Museum Vlenna - Treasures of the Habsburgs 4hrs







Over the centuries the art-loving members of the House of Habsburg collected and commissioned a wealth of magnificent artworks, amassing a rich – material and immaterial – heritage. The importance of this patrimony is reflected in the fact that it was housed in close vicinity to the Imperial Hofburg Palace.

This is where the Imperial Treasury Vienna is located. It houses unique objects of outstanding historical and religious importance such as the crown of the Holy Roman Empire or the crown of Emperor Rudolf II., later the Austrian Imperial crown.



The most important treasury in the world is home to two imperial crowns as well as the



Burgundian treasure and the treasure of the Order of the Golden Fleece.

The Imperial Crown of the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation is the highlight of the collection: Created in the second half of the 10th century, it was used to crown the empire's emperors. The octagonal crown was highly symbolic and is decorated with numerous biblical references.

The second important crown in the Imperial Treasury is the Austrian imperial crown. It was made in 1602 as a private

crown for Emperor Rudolf II. (1552-1612). From 1804, it acted as the crown of the newly created Austrian Empire. However, it was never used to crown an Austrian emperor.





### **Unicorn and Holy Grail**

Also on exhibit are the Burgundian treasure from the 15th century and the treasure of the Order of the Golden Fleece (the Habsburg dynastic order). One of the biggest emeralds in the world and many other richly decorated pieces of temporal and spiritual power can also be seen, such as two "inalienable heirlooms of the House of Austria": a giant narwhal tooth, which was believed to come from a unicorn, and a late antiquity agate bowl, which was considered to be the legendary Holy Grail.

The entrance to the Treasuries can be found in the Schweizerhof, whose name is reminiscent of the Swiss Guard that was once posted here.

The Dancing School Elmayer was founded by the former officer of the Austrian Imperial Army Willy Elmayer von Vestenbrugg in 1919. Ever since the dancing school Elmayer is situated in the rooms of the former horse stables in the Pallavicini Palace next to the stables of the Spanish Riding School – home of the famous white stallions – in the heart of Vienna.

Elmayer is combining tuition in manners and dancing based on the traditional Austrian imperial system that is carefully but continuously adapted to modern times. As such the Elmayer "Dancing School" is unique in the world today.

Fortunately we found an easy and very relaxed and entertaining way to enable everybody to acquire the know how to dance Viennese Waltz within the shortest period of time. And you can be sure to have cherished and lasting memories on this unique and most enjoyable experience.

This activity is totally independent of climatic circumstances – cool (air-conditioned) in summer and dry and warm in winter. Don't forget to take along clean shoes with smooth soles especially in case of bad weather outside.

Vienna State Opera:





Today, the Vienna State Opera is considered one of the most important opera houses in the world; in particular, it is the house with the largest repertoire. It has been under the direction of Dominique Meyer, along with musical director Franz Welser-Möst, since September 1, 2010.

More information on the specific performance to follow once the Schedules have been released and confirmed.
