Take a ride on the Bernina Express, Switzerland's alpine delight. This train journey takes you along one of the most beautiful railway routes in the world – now a UNESCO World Heritage Site – through the Bernina Pass to the exclusive resort of St Moritz at the 'Top of the World.'

Enjoy a round-trip scenic coach trip and ride a bright red rail car, passing unrivaled landscapes amid the

towering peaks of the Swiss Alps, including time to spend in the charming towns of Tirano and St Mortiz.

Your rail journey starts amid the palms and oleanders of northern Italy, taking you over the spiraling viaduct at Brusio and through the Bernina Pass into Engadin, arriving in St Moritz 2.5 hours later. Known as the 'Little Red Train,' the Bernina Express was built more than 100 years ago to scale the majestic mountain landscapes of the Swiss Alps. This historical feat of engineering still climbs up the 7,330-foot (2,235meter) high Bernina Pass along a UNESCO World Heritage-listed route.



Depart by comfortable coach from Milan at 7am and enjoy a scenic bus tour to the Swiss town of Tirano, situated at the foothills of the Alps. Pass mountain streams and forested hills against a backdrop of steep, snow-capped peaks. 

- It is obligatory to deposit in the cloakroom knives, scissors, any tools that could be harmful to other persons or damage works of art in the Museums.
- It is not possible to deposit in the cloakroom, firearms of any kind or other dangerous objects. It is strictly forbidden to enter the Museums with any kind of weapon.
- Access to the Museums by armed visitors is not permitted. No exception to this rule is made for visitors holding a firearm permit, or if the weapon forms part of a uniform (police, military or others).

after you are comfortable with the Segway, you will begin your tour through the streets of Rome.



Glide toward the area known as Capitoline Hill, and as you approach it you'll be met with the jaw-dropping sights of Ancient Rome. Once the home of richly elaborate temples, shops, markets and government buildings, the area is now a fascinating archeological site peppered with 2,000-year-old world-famous ruins.

Head right up to it and weave around the outskirts of the Roman Forum, seeing grandiose monuments like the Arch of Constantine and Trajan's Column. Hear the history of the site in its heyday from your audio commentary, learning about its status as the administrative center of Rome.



Pass Palentine Hill and stop for a look at Circus Maximus, the vast stretch of flat land where chariot races were once held to entertain up to 250,000 locals. Continue to the Colosseum, Rome's iconic monument on the east side of Ancient Rome, and stop for photos while listening to commentary about the gory, yet glorified, gladiator battles that once took place inside.




Then continue to the Piazza della Signoria – Florence's central square.

Photograph the Palazzo Vecchio city hall and statues that frame the square, including the copy of Michelangelo's David.





Then, walk to the Arno River and cross the magnificent Ponte Vecchio. Built in the 14th century, this exquisite, shop-lined bridge cries out to be caught on camera.

Stop en-route to capture the city's highlights on camera, as well as some lesser-known sights. Learn how to 'spot' great photos, master light and composition, and get invaluable tips on how to use your camera settings to best effect.

Continue to the Piazza della Repubblica, once the site of the Roman Forum, and now flanked by cafés. Capture the bustle here before strolling to the Church of Orsanmichele to photograph the statues that adorn this former 13th century granary.

Lastly, visit the Ponte Santa Trinita, the arched bridge designed by Ammannati in the 16th century with tips from Michelangelo.



Point your camera at its statues and the Arno River from here before ending your tour (3 hours).

Lunch is on your own. You will have 3 hours to eat, relax, or explore on your own until your afternoon tour.





2:30 pm: Meet your private Englishspeaking professional guide in the lobby of your hotel (or if you stay in town you can meet your guide at the Piazza della Signoria, in central Florence) for a private tour of Florence Duomo with Brunelleschi's Dome Climb.

You will Skip the 2 Hr. wait Lines and climb to the top of Brunelleschi's Dome with your expert guide!

Majestically dominating the city skyline, the terracotta dome of Basilica di Santa Maria del Fiore (or Florence Duomo, as it's more commonly known) is easily Florence's most iconic attraction.

After experiencing this masterpiece of architectural genius, head inside the Cathedral Workshop to learn more about Filippo Brunelleschi, the dome's Renaissance architect.

After explaining the history of the Renaissance dome (known as the cupola) your guide will lead the way straight up its impressive 463-step staircase.

Taking roughly 45 minutes, the walk up the steps is not for the faint-hearted! Be prepared for a steep and narrow climb – hard work but most definitely worth it.

As you ascend through the 'onion layers', or two shells, of the dome, pass fascinating frescoes from esteemed Renaissance artists like Vasari and Zuccari.

Once at the top, enjoy simply incomparable views over Florence and the Tuscan hills. Walk around the dome's balcony to take photos and soak up the sights, while your guide regales you with tales of Filippo Brunellechi, the talented Renaissance architect who created the dome itself.



After spending roughly 30 minutes at the top, start the careful descent back down the stairs. Relax at the bottom, before heading inside the Cathedral Workshop (Museum of

Opera del Duomo) to explore with your guide. Hear about the engineering conundrum faced by Brunelleschi -- to create a dome for the 150-foot (45-meter) space without scaffolding or pillars -- and see tools used in the dome's construction, alongside Gothic and Renaissance sculptures. Your guided tour ends inside the museum.

Break Time: After your tour you will have approximately an hour and a half to relax in the city, perhaps have a coffee in a café or do some shopping.



Florence River Cruise on a Traditional Barchetto - 6:30 pm:

After your break, make your way to the departure point in central Florence (Directions will be delivered to you prior to your departure) where you will meet your Englishspeaking professional local guide for a 30 minute walk to the Riverside.

Your local historian guide will introduce you to

the many charms of the city!

Walk through the distinctive Piazza Signoria, often considered the political hub of Florence, and pass the Uffizi Gallery before seeing the Ponte Vecchio, Florence's famous bridge that stretches across the Arno.

At the embarkation point, hop aboard your boat, one of Florence's rare original barchettos, and head down the Arno on a one-hour cruise. Meaning 'little boat' in Italian, the barchetto is a wooden gondola-style boat that was originally used (centuries ago) to carry building materials for Florence's city walls down the river.

While your guide unveils the secrets of the beautiful palaces that frame the riverside, your barcaiolo, a true Florentine boat-handler, will expertly guide your barchetto with a long wooden oar.

Relaxing with a glass of Prosecco, you'll glide past the Uffizi Gallery, one of the most famous art museums in Italy, before sailing under the unique Ponte Vecchio.

As you cruise, your guide will talk about the mysterious Vasari Corridor, the enclosed passageway that lines the Ponte Vecchio, and will explain the town's history.



You will also see countless other Florence attractions during your cruise, such as the Santa Trinita Bridge and Corsini Palace with its stunning Baroque architecture (1 ½ Hr.).

After your boat tour, you will be delivered to the pier, where you can enjoy a leisurly walk back to your hotel, stay in the area and explore a little more on your own, or hail a taxi to return to your hotel to relax until dinner.
