Day 1 Arrival Holland - Netherlands: US - Amsterdam



Upon arrival in Amsterdam, enjoy a comfortable and efficient luxury VIP meet and greet service. Beginning from the aircraft, escorting you right to your waiting driver for a transfer to Hotel The First.

- You will be met at the aircraft with a name sign, at this point you will be escorted through immigration.
- Your assistant will be on hand to collect all your baggage off the carousel and escort you curbside to meet your English Speaking Driver for a transfer to hotel The First.



- This service includes full assistance in case of flight delays, cancellation or passenger delay and special needs. (Assistant at disposal for 1 hour)
- Please note that porterage service is not included however if you wish
- you may request this locally and pay for it directly to the porters.
- Transfer to the hotel Hotel de l'Europe by private English Speaking Driver. Your English Speaking Driver will meet you in the Main Arrival Hall (Holding up a sign with your names). Direct transfer from the airport to your hotel in Amsterdam, hotel de l' Europe. Estimated transfer time is approximately 35 minutes.

Upon arrival at the hotel, The Hotel de l'Europe, where you have a Penthouse Suite with Terrace reserved for 4 nights. Breakfast, services and taxes included. You will be met by the Concierge who will welcome you to Amsterdam with a private and immediate VIP check-in experience. Your luggage will be managed and delivered to your accommodation.

After check-in, you are at leisure to settle into your suite and relax a bit.

9:00am: You have spa appointments for treatments for the remainder of the morning (pre-arranged based on your preferences you selected in the Celebration Escapes' Creative Planning Session.) The wine list contains over 150 Italian wines.

On the third floor there is a lounge area where

smoking is allowed.









Day 2 Holland - Netherlands: Amsterdam

Breakfast in the hotel.

After breakfast, you will meet your private English-speaking driver & professional local guide in the lobby of your hotel for a private Culinary Tour (4 Hrs).

Get acquainted with the best local foods and tastes of Amsterdam.







You will go to various shops and **markets** with a private guide accompanying you through a maze of Amsterdam's many culinary shops. Learn how local delicacies are made and your guide will advise on items that you might enjoy. During the tour you will visit some secret eateries that are off the map (known only by the locals) so that you get to experience the sounds and smell of Amsterdam's best dining experiences.

Tip: Good food doesn't have to be expensive in Amsterdam!

The wonderful **Dutch cheeses**, **ox sausage** and **homemade chocolate bonbons**. Of course, no food tour of Amsterdam would be complete without the standard local favorites, **raw herring** or **stroopwafels**. By the 1640's there were over 50 sugar refineries in Amsterdam. To this day bakeries making sweets from multiple nations flourish in Amsterdam, and we also stop at some of the best for those who have a sweet tooth.

1:00 PM: Lunch: On your own – Your guide will have recommendations in the area for lunch.

After lunch, you will be returned to your hotel, where the remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to continue exploring on your own or relax in your hotel.





6:15 PM: Depart for Restaurant (an 8 minute walk to the Rembrandt House on your own.

6:30 PM: Dinner: After hours VIP House visit with Private dinner at the Rembrandt House museum in Rembrandt's Kitchen.

Private VIP afterhours visit at the house of Rembrandt- <u>Unique VIP Exclusive Experience</u>
Rembrandt lived and worked in this beautiful and monumental house between 1639 and 1658.

Based on an inventory of the time, the house has been redecorated with furniture, art and objects dating from the 17th century. In the Rembrandt House there are daily demonstrations of etching and paint preparation that show you the way he worked in that period of time.

On top of that, there is a private interactive workshop that is offered, giving you the opportunity to do your own etching in Rembrandt's student studio (Leerlingenatelier).

The Rembrandt House owns the virtually complete and world famous collection of Rembrandt's etchings. In addition, there are frequent temporary exhibitions showing work of predecessors and contemporaries, and modern and current works of art in the modern wing of the museum.

6:30-7:30 pm: Guided private tour through the house in English, including participation in a paint preparation workshop in Rembrandt's former studio.

Day 3 Holland - Netherlands: Amsterdam - Delft - The Hague - Madurodam

Breakfast in the hotel.

After breakfast, you will meet your private English-speaking driver & Professional Local Guide in the lobby of the hotel for a very interesting tour and VIP Exclusive tour of Delft, The Hague and Madurodam – 6 Hours.

Go beyond Amsterdam with a half-day tour of two important Dutch cities: Delft and The Hague. Admire the Netherlands' famous Delft blue-and-white pottery on a tour of the Royal Delft, followed by free time to explore Delft's historic city center.



During this tour you will visit two cities which have both played a crucial role in the history of the Netherlands: The Hague and Delft. You will see some of the highlights of these cities.























Royal the Hague and Delft



We start with a visit to Delft and walk through the old center along canals and historic almshouses. Visit The Royal Dutch Delftware factory "De Porceleyne Fles". The factory was established in 1653 and is the last remaining Delftware factory from the 17th century. The world famous Royal Delftware is still entirely hand-painted according to a centuries old tradition.



Delft Blue Tile painting workshop - <u>Unique VIP Exclusive Experience</u>

Combine a guided tour of the Royal Delft Blue museum and factory with an inspiring and creative workshop. Paint your own Delft Blue tile, under the guidance of a professional painter. With paint brushes and Delft Blue paint you create a wonderful souvenir and have a unique experience.

You can do this by using stencils (patterns) or you can make your own design. Workshops can be arranged in the morning between 9am and 2pm on weekdays. In weekends the workshop starts at 2.30pm.

This program includes a visit to the factory and museum, the painting workshop and coffee or tea with something sweet. It takes 2 ½ hours total. The pieces cannot be taken home immediately as they need to be glazed and finished off in the oven first. After 5 days the pieces can be collected or sent to your address. The postage costs will be charged separately and are not included in the costs of the workshop.

Lunch on your own en-route. (TBD with guide on site – Additional payment at time of service with restaurant).

Then take a sightseeing tour of The Hague, one of the Netherlands most important cities. The seat of the Dutch Parliament, whose sights include the Binnenhof complex,



the Parliament buildings, Noordeinde Palace and the Peace Palace, home to the International Court of Justice.



Your guide will provide insightful commentary throughout the afternoon. The Hague, on a half-day trip from Amsterdam. Home to the Dutch government, foreign embassies and many important international organizations.











The Hague features both historic sites such as the Binnenhof, and iconic modern institutions including the Peace Palace and International Court of Justice. Your guide explains the importance of these places as you take in the handsome city center.













Proceed from The Hague for a visit to the miniature village of **Madurodam**. Finish the day with a visit to the Madurodam, an outdoor park with detailed replicas of the most famous sights in the Netherlands.







For more than 55 years Madurodam has been the smallest city in the Netherlands. Canals, gabled houses and all kinds of other typical Dutch scenes: the miniature city offers you all the highlights of the Netherlands on a scale 1 - .25.

3:00pm: You will be returned to your hotel after the tour. The remainder of the

afternoon is at leisure to explore on your own or relax in your hotel.

Depart from the hotel to the Museum Square. A visit will be made to the National museum of Amsterdam, "the Rijksmuseum".



This museum features the largest collection of paintings by the Dutch masters such as Frans Hals, Jan Steen and Rembrandt and his the famous "Night Watch".

We begin with a private VIP Rembrandt Art Tour – a walking tour that includes VIP access and private tour of the Rijksmuseum, the most famous

art museum in Amsterdam.

Relive the glory of the most famous painter of the Dutch Golden Age, Rembrandt van Rijn, on this customizable private walking tour in Amsterdam.

Marvel at Rembrandt's most celebrated paintings including 'The Night Watch,' 'The Jewish Bride,' 'Syndics of the Drapers' Guild' and his signature portraits. Proceed through this museum to see some very special pieces and explore areas of the museum that only a few are granted access.











Next to the Rijksmuseum, we find the famous Van Gogh Museum.

The museum contains the largest collection of paintings by Vincent van Gogh in the world.

3:00 PM: End of the private Museum Tours at the location for the private workshop









3:00 PM: Visit the private studio of artist & society lady Ans Markus and take part in her workshop – 2 Hrs – <u>Unique VIP Exclusive Experience</u>

Ans gives a guided tour of her work and recounts in passing how she decided to take up painting. An increasing number of groups actually want to paint during their visit. As soon as they arrive, they are given an apron to protect their clothes against paint splashes. Cotton aprons, complete with the date and a logo, can be ordered in advance.

On plastic-covered marble floor a dozen or so easels with canvas stretchers are set up. Here all members of the group can roll up their sleeves and paint to their heart's content. Just before the group's departure, the paintings that they have made are commented on by Ans. This is invariably followed by applause from everyone present, who only an hour before all had been struggling with the same creative input! 2 hour visit of the private studio including workshop ** *Transportation costs for delivering the paintings to the hotel are included*


