Vienna, Austria's capital, lies in the country's east on the Danube River. Its artistic and intellectual legacy was shaped by residents including Mozart, Beethoven and Sigmund Freud. The city is also known for its Imperial palaces, including Schönbrunn, the Habsburgs' summer residence. In the MuseumsQuartier district, historic and contemporary buildings display works by Egon Schiele, Gustav Klimt and other artists.

Morning: City Walk 3hrs

This interesting city walk offers you an initial overview of the history and the structure of the city. It takes you through the most beautiful and most elegant streets to the most famous sights in Vienna. Your tour focuses on the Hofburg, residence of the Habsburgs for nearly 650 years and St. Stephen's Cathedral, the landmark of Vienna. There will be no lack of tales about the Habsburgs – e.g. Sisi and Franz Joseph – the marriage and burial rites, or the stories concerning the Sachertorte and coffee houses.

Evening: Johann Strauss Concerts at Wiener Kursalon –

In the very place where Johann Strauss himself used to direct his orchestra from the position of first violin, the absolute essence of Vienna's classical music can once again be heard daily. The Salonorchester Alt Wien, one of the best-known interpreters of classical Viennese music, presents and evening full of Viennese charm wit the lilting sound of waltzes, polkas, arias and duets, as well as operetta and piano concerto melodies. Accompanied by excellent opera vocalists and enchanting ballet soloists, Vienna's classical music reveals itself as a living firework display for all the senses.

At your leisure, you will continue on to the Kunsthistorisches Museum. This is a Fine arts museum in palatial building Imposing, 19th-century museum with lavish interiors housing Habsburgs art collections & antiquities.

You will stop for lunch at a local restaurant. Your guide will offer suggestions. Luch is on your own (Payment at time of service)

At your leisure, you will continue on to the Belvedere Palace; a Baroque, 18th-century palaces housing art from Middle Ages to today, with notable Klimt collection.

In Eisenstadt, we visit the Esterhazy Palace, once the residence of the Hungarian Princes, and many years the home of the composer Joseph Haydn. The castle's magnificent ambience invites you to a fascinating journey into the world of the Esterhazy Princes. The castle-staff slips into the role of the Grand Controller and receives visitors in courtly tradition. (Original filming location of an Austrian TV series "The King of Winegrowers").

After a short walk through the old town, we drive through the countryside of Lake Neusiedl, an area on the UNESCO list of world heritage sights.

In Rust, the city of storks, you have the possibility for lunch accompanied by Gipsy Music.

Enjoy an impressing boat cruise on Lake Neusiedl, which is Europe's largest steppe lake and a unique paradise for birds on the Austrian-Hungarian border.

After the tour, you will be returned to your hotel where you will be at leisure for the remainder of the day.

Salzburg is an Austrian city on the border of Germany, with views of the Eastern Alps. The city is divided by the Salzach River, with medieval and baroque buildings of the pedestrian Altstadt (Old City) on its left bank, facing the 19th-century Neustadt (New City) on its right. The Altstadt birthplace of famed composer Mozart is preserved as a museum displaying his childhood instruments.

This tour will show you the main sights of the beautiful festival city of Salzburg, including Mirabell Castle, Mozart's birthplace, the horse fountain, St Peters cathedral.
