Arrival into Fiumicino airport - Private Minivan transfer from Rome airport to Rome Hotel .

This sophisticated location is dedicated to the oil and wine tasting experience and to high level gastronomy.

Day 4: Florence - Florence

Breakfast in the Hotel

After breakfast, meet your English-speaking professional local guide for a walking tour of the city.



Enjoy this morning a very special walking tour of Florence taking in the highlights of this amazing with city with your local expert guide: The guide's flexibility allows for adaptation to your areas of interest.

While those who have visited Florence before may have special requests, we suggest the following for a first visit to this city:

- •Piazza della Signoria, one of the most beautiful squares in the world, with its open-air display of masterpieces of Renaissance and Baroque sculpture. The backdrop is the medieval Palazzo Vecchio, the city's seat of government for over 700 years. Together with your guide, explore the fascinating history of Florence, as the heroes from the Old Testament or Greek mythology, depicted here in marble and bronze, served as political messages for the ruler of the moment.
- •Piazza del Duomo, the Cathedral square, where from the outside we can admire the graceful Gothic bell-tower and the Romanesque baptistery with its beautiful gilded bronze doors. The most famous of the doors are the "Gates of Paradise" by Lorenzo Ghiberti, with their stories from the Old Testament, a masterpiece of the early Renaissance. The Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore is crowned with its imposing dome, an amazing challenge of engineering to be solved only by the genius of Brunelleschi. We discuss how the difficulties were to be overcome in the most imaginative of ways.







- •The Ponte Vecchio, or "old bridge" and its tantalizing jewelry shops. Beautiful hand-made gold jewelry is a "centuries-long" tradition in this city, dating back to the pre-Roman era of the Etruscans. This medieval bridge is the oldest spanning the Arno River, offering lovely views of the city and the hills beyond.
- •The Academy of Fine Arts, founded in 1563, was the first school established in Europe specifically to teach the techniques of drawing, painting and sculpture. The art collection displayed here was formed in 1784 with the aim of providing material for students to study and copy. The most famous work on display is Michelangelo's David (1504), a colossal nude of the biblical hero who killed the giant Goliath. Other



masterpieces here include the Quattro Prigioni sculpted between 1521 and 1523 and intended to adorn the tomb of Pope Julius II.

•We also strongly recommend a visit to the Franciscan church of Santa Croce and its neighborhood. This is the perfect setting for further discussion of the artistic and political history of this great city. The church serves as a pantheon to Italian genius with monuments to such as Michelangelo, Machiavelli and Galileo. There are also fine examples of the work of artists such as Giotto, Donatello and Brunelleschi.

The Franciscans' Leather School still operates in the rooms of the old convent behind the church: here classes are conducted and fine leather articles are produced and sold. It is possible to observe the master craftsmen and their students at work.

You will also discover lesser-known corners of the city, quiet back streets of the neighbourhood, craftsmen's workshops and curiosities of life in Florence, both present-day and medieval. Here is located one of the city's most fascinating of workshops where it is possible to watch the masters creating beautiful pieces in semi-precious inlaid stone with the same tools and techniques of the past.

The city is so seeped in history, the quality of its artists and craftsmen is so superlative, there are so many delights to discover, you will be left, wanting always more!(tour duration 4 hours)


Time at leisure for independent exploring...

This afternoon, enjoy a visit with your Private English Speaking Guide the beautiful Uffizi gallery with prearranged entrances...

The Uffizi, Italy's great art gallery, was built in 1560 – 80 to house offices for Duke Cosimo I. The architect Vasari used iron as reinforcement, which enabled his successor Buontalenti to create an almost continuous wall of glass on the upper story.

This was used as a gallery for Francesco I to display the Medici art treasures. The collection was divided up in the 19th century: ancient objects went to the archaeological museum and sculpture to the Bargello, leaving the Uffizi with a matchless collection of paintings.











Dinner reservation at the Osteria di Giovanni restaurant – payment for dinner direct to the restaurant.

This charming family-run restaurant dates back to 1951 when it stared as a tiny wine shop offering a small selection of typical Tuscan delicacies. It is now located in the original stables of Palazzo Rucellai, creating an informal, vibrant yet elegant restaurant.

It is only 10 minutes from Piazza della Signoria and from Ponte Vecchio, and has the famous shopping of via Tornabuoni and via della Vigna Nuova just round the corner. It is a popular meeting place with good food and wine, and warm and relaxed atmosphere. The menu includes favourites such a Veal Ossobuco, fresh fish of the day, and homemade ravioli and tortelli. Casual but Elegant Atmosphere. After dinner you are at leisure to continue exploration on your own or to return to the hotel and relax.

Day 5: Florence - Florence

Breakfast in the Hotel

After breakfast, meet your English-speaking professional local guide for a walking tour of the West Bank.

Enjoy a wonderful stroll through the Left Bank Side of Florence with your Local Expert Guide taking in the this amazing area as well as the Pitti Palace and Boboli Gardens...

Our walk takes us over the Ponte Vecchio to the south side of the Arno River, through the streets of a lesser-known part of Florence where tradition survives. The workshops,



small boutiques and little squares, make this one of the most delightful quarters of the city. Here, some restoration clinics are working on the elaborate frames for the very paintings we shall be seeing.

The Palazzo Pitti, with its extensive gardens behind, is an impressive complex, housing an immense collection of art in several different museums. The palace was originally built in the 15th century for the wealthy banker Luca Pitti. The Pitti were determined to outrival the Medici: the windows were to be larger than the doors of the Medici.

Ironically, when the building costs bankrupted Luca Pitti's heirs, the Medici purchased the property and began a lengthy project to enlarge and embellish the palace. In 1550, it became the main residence of the Grand-dukes, successively, of the Austrian rulers, of Napoleon's sister, Elisa and later, of the first King of Italy during that brief period when Florence was capital of the newly formed Kingdom.







The apartments, with their rich decoration, reflect the taste of the various periods. For the Medici, it was an impressive stage for a family that had quickly risen from mere merchants to Grand-dukes, with an aspiration to become the Kings of Tuscany. The Medici's residence, with its opulent interiors, superlative collections of masterpieces and gardens full of marvels, will be inspiration for the French kings at Versailles and

Fontainbleau.

Our visit to the Palatine Gallery takes us through lavish settings with masterpieces of Renaissance painters: such as Raphael, Titian, Rubens. There are beautiful furnishings and delightful views out over the gardens directly behind the palace. (Tour duration-4 hours)

Our Balloon will land in Chianti where, accompanied by our pilot, we will enjoy a pleasant Chianti Picnic Breakfast before returning with our driver to the hotel.

Upon arrival at your hotel, you will be welcomed with a VIP check-in experience. Your luggage will be managed and delivered to your accommodation. The hotel, Castel Monastero Hotel, where you have reserved rooms with breakfast, service and taxes included for 2 nights.

In the well-known Valley del l'Ombrone, just 23 KM from Siena, rises the Castel Monasterio, set in an intact ancient medieval village, dating back to the 11th century. It is known as one of the finest monasteries of Ombnrone. Long stretches of vineyards of Chianti, chestnut forests and hills covered with wheat are the framework for this witness of Tuscan nobility.



The property is set on four acres of greenery, from any corner it offers a view of vineyards, and olive groves. It has been restored respecting the tradition and the origins of this ancient country house, even though it has been enriched with elements of modern design.









Restaurants

In collaboration with Gordon Ramsey, winner of 10 Michelin stars, under the direction of Alexander Delfanti, skilful chef, the "Gourmet" restaurant in the village square will be happy to amaze guests of Castel Monastero with the best of traditional Tuscan cuisine.

It is know for the genuineness of its excellent dishes. Amyone wishing to deepen the knowledge of Tuscan wine traditions, will go to the "Cellar", where under the guidance of expert sommeliers, will enjoy the best regional wines and the vintages of Chianti produced in the estate, accompanying them with the tasting of typical specialities of the area.

During the day, guests can visit the bar in the square where they can have the possibility to sip herbal teas made with Tuscan herbs, prepared according to old recipes.

It's then onto the Azienda, Agricola Paradiso, where we will enhoy a late lunch including many Tuscan specialities, as well as the opportunity to taste three of our favorite Tuscany wines. Of course, at least one of these wines will be the world remowned "Brunello di Montalcino".
