Day 1 Arrival: US - Dublin

TBD: Arrive Dublin Airport.

Upon your return from your fishing excursion, you will check out of the hotel. Your luggage will be managed and you are free to have lunch in the hotel.



After lunch, meet your private driver in the lobby of your hotel for your transfer to Dublin. (3.5 hrs. transfer)

If you are extending your stay in Belfast, you will be returned to your hotel.

If your flight to the US is tonight, you will be transferred to the Airport to meet your international flight to the U.S. & Home.

If you are joining the Second half of this trip for the River Cruise, or you are extending your stay in Dublin, you will be transferred for check in at the Fitzwilliam Hotel, in the city center.

Details of Golf Courses

Links Golf Courses – Dublin area

Portmarnock --- Architects: W. Pickeman/G. Ross 18 holes (1896); 7,466yds, Par 72





Portmarnock is arguably one of the top Links golf courses in the World. Host to numerous professional and amateur events including 19 Irish Opens, Walker Cup an World Cup, the course offers legendary Links golf from the 1st Tee to the 18th green

A natural Links course with water on three sides, the course is at the mercy of the wind. Laid out broadly in two lops of nine holes, you are invariably playing in different direction and it is a formidable test of golf.

The greens are lightning fast an true so you will need your very best putting game.

The European - Architect: Pat Ruddy (1993), 18 holes; 7,355 par 71



Located in magnificent sand dunes on the Irish sea about 30 miles south of Dublin city center, this world-renowned course is regularly ranked as one of the world's top 10 Links course to play.

An inspiring place for golf, huge dunes provide tremendous definition and the Irish Sea is very much a backcloth.

The Royal Dublin Golf Club Architects: Harry Colt & Martin Hawtree (1885); 18 holes 7,269 yards, Par 72



As the second oldest golf course in Ireland, dating back to 1885, the course has a dynamic history and has a true championship layout with classic out and back. It is highly rated with the pros, and one pro in particular has fallen in love with Royal Dublin. Christy O'Connor was the club pro in 1959 and has firmly been attached ever since. The club granted the nine



times Irish Open Champion honorary life membership. Why not invite him to join you for a round on his favorite course? The greens are outstanding and the course lies flat with narrow and long stretches calling for accurate drives.

Parkland Golf Courses – Dublin area

The K Club - Palmer Ryder Cup Course - Architect: Arnold Palmer (1991), 18 holes:7,337 yards, par 72



A golf holiday in Ireland would not be complete without a visit to the K Club.

Regularly ranked in the top 3 parkland golf courses in Ireland, the Palmer Ryder Cup course is quite simply one of Europe's most spectacular courses.

A must play "badge of honor" that has hosted the top golf players in the world during the Ryder Cup in 2006, and 11 European Opens.

Carton House – Montgomerie. Architects: Colin Montgomerie & Stan Eby (2002); 18 holes, 7,301 yards par 72



Located just 15 miles from the west of Dublin city center, the course has been designated the host for the Irish Open 2013. With a modern look and feel, the course gets its definition between the cuts of grass and the many deep pot bunkers.

Druids Glen – Architect: Pat Ruddy & Tom Craddock (1995) 18 holes; 7,046 yards, Par 71





Often refereed to as the "Augusta of Europe' there is more color here than any other course in Ireland. With its brilliant flora and card-wrecking stretch of holes from the 12th to the 14th, called 'Ireland's Amen Corner', the course feels like a class American Country Club.

With manicured greens and generous fairways, scoring well could become a real possibility. However, don't be fooled as there are many varied challenges with wat everywhere. If you are not on top of your game, it can be brutal.

Links Courses – NE Ireland

Royal County Down – Championship Course. Architects: Old Tom Morris, Harry Vardon & Harry Colt (1889 onwards) Length: 18 holes, 7,186 yards, par 71



The course is located in one of the world's most naturally beautiful links settings in the Murlough Nature Reserve.

Against the magnificent backdrop of the Mountains o Mourne, the links stretches

along the shores of Dundrum Bay, zigzagging back and forth to provide a different vista from virtually every hole.

The narrowest ribbons of fairways thread their way through as impressive a set of sand dunes as could be imagined. The fairways are surrounded by purple heather an golden gorse, so beautiful to look at but so punishing for any who may stray from th prescribed path. The greens are fast and many are domed, rejecting any shot lackin conviction. This is a true test of any player's command of the traditional bump and run, the preferred way to play any links.

Royal Portrush – Dunluce, Architect: Harry Colt (1888 onwards) Length: 18 holes, 7,143 yards, Par 72





Venue for the Irish Open 2012, Royal Portrush Golf Club is home to one of the best and most challenging links golf courses in the world, the Dunluce Links. The only clu in Ireland to have hosted The Open Championship, Royal Portrush stands on a rocky promontory that just out into the

Atlantic with the tall limestone cliffs that lead to Dunluce Castle after which the course is named. A seaside links paradise where the fairways nestle in natural valleys between towering sand dunes. The course will intimidate many golfers, and requires solid driving to hold together a decent score

Portmarnock -- Architects: W. Pickeman/G. Ross 18 holes (1896) Length: 18+ 9 holes, 7,466yds, Par 72
