della Signoria, one of the most beautiful squares in the world. The backdrop is the medieval Palazzo Vecchio, the city's seat of government for over 700 years.

Piazza del Duomo, the Cathedral square, where from the outside we can admire the graceful Gothic bell-tower and the Romanesque baptistery with its beautiful gilded bronze doors, the "Gates of Paradise" by Lorenzo Ghiberti.

Admire Brunelleschi's Dome, the largest dome ever built in masonry. The Ponte Vecchio, or "old bridge" and its tantalizing jewellery shops.

You will also discover lesser-known corners of the city, and quiet back streets of the neighbourhood. The city is so seeped in history, the quality of its artists and craftsmen is so superlative, there are so many delights to discover, you will be left wanting more! (Tour Duration: 4 Hours)

Semi-previous inlaid stone, Florentine coloured paper, leather craftsman, gold and bronze workers, painters of miniatures, frame-makers, all of these creations made using the same tools and techniques of the past. Day 1 Florence: Florence City

Breakfast in the Hotel



After breakfast, meet your private English-speaking driver & professional local guide in the lobby of your hotel when you will enjoy the 'Complete' Introduction to the Highlights of Florence.

The best way to see Florence in a day! We begin with a private car and driver at your disposal for three hours to see the highlights of the city, including The Academy of Fine Arts, with The David and other sculptures by Michelangelo. Visit Santa Croce, the Franciscan church where Michelangelo is buried, along with Galileo, Rossini and Macchiavelli. Here are also splendid works of Giotto, Donatello and Brunelleschi.











At the end of the three hours, our driver will leave us in the Signoria Square. Here, we shall have a short break, perhaps at the fashionable Cafe Rivoire, before a tour of the nearby Gallery of the Uffizi to see the highlights of Renaissance masterpieces in painting in a setting that once served as the offices, or administrative headquarters, for the Medici, when they ruled Tuscany as the Grand- dukes. (total tour duration with guide: 5 hours – duration touring with car/driver service: 3 hours)

Day 2 Florence: Tuscany & Florence

At 5 am, enjoy Tuscany from the Skies – a very special sunrise experience awaits you..

Enjoy a very special Tuscany experience which begins at sunrise with an early morning departure from your hotel. On arrival at the site, your experience begins assisting the pilot in the balloons' preparation then its onwards and upwards as we head up into the



Tuscan Skies to enjoy a very special unique and enchanting experience. The flight, whose duration is approximately 50 minutes, will take us through the heart of the Chianti Region allowing us to enjoy the famous rolling hills of Chianti, the vineyards, olive groves, farm houses and characteristic hillside towns. Our Balloon will land in Chianti where, accompanied by our pilot, we will enjoy a pleasant Chianti Picnic Breakfast before returning with our driver to the hotel.

Day 3 Florence: Florence & Tuscany

After breakfast, meet your private English-speaking driver & professional local guide int the lobby of the hotel for your morning tour.



This morning, enjoy the Hill towns of – Explore the hills above Florence and discover lovely landscape within short distance of the city center.

Drive out of the city and into the hills north of Fiesole and Settignano. Fiesole boasts Etruscan walls, a temple and bath as well as an impressive theatre, still in use today. It is possible to see the juxtaposition of the level of civilization from the Etruscan, through the Roman to the Dark Ages. The views to the olive-clad hills north are stunning. Inside the little museum are some exceptional treasures, including beautiful ceramics. Learn more about the intriguing Etruscans that inhabited Fiesole, before the arrival of the Romans.

Nearby, at Settignano are the lovely grounds of Villa Gamberaia, one of the most charming of gardens. Enjoy the different corners and views across the valley while learning about the Renaissance garden, the Tuscan villa and the lifestyle of its inhabitants.

Proceed then to the hill just above Florence, to the south, from which there is spectacular view of the city. Visit San Miniato, a rare example of the Romanesque style. This hilltop jewel boasts a lovely façade, beautiful inlaid floors, mosaic apse, as well as an interesting collection of frescoes. Most afternoons, it is possible to hear the Gregorian chant of the Olivetan monks.

From here it is even possible to stroll down the hill to the medieval walls and gate of the San Niccolo quarter, a charming neighbourhood across the Arno from the city centre. (tour duration: 4 hours)

During the trip your expert Driver introduces you to one of Italy's most beautiful regions, its people, culture, wines and way of life.

Once you are in Siena at around 10.30am enjoy a private cooking class with Lella Cesari Ciampoli After your class you will enjoy the delights of your efforts for llunch with your host.

Lella Cesari Ciampoli's Cookery School was the first to be founded in Siena and quickly gained recognition as one of Italy's top 100 cookery schools. Lella has been teaching for many years, and is a member, among others, of the AICI (Association of Italian Cookery Teachers) and of the International Association of Cooking Professionals of Washington DC. Lella is well known as a passionate researcher into traditional Tuscan and medieval cuisine and has worked with the major Italian culinary publications, as well as publishing



her own cook book in Japan, entitled 'The Pleasures of Italian Cooking'. She is currently working on a cook book in English.











Following time in Siena continue North West to the town of towers, San Gimignano. During the transfer from Siena to San Gimignano your local expert Driver will give you some great tips on how to get the most out of your time here. From San Gimignano the return journey to Florence will take you a different route to give you some more special glimpses of this beautiful area. (tour duration: 8 hours)

Today enjoy the Day exploring the Famous Food and Wine Towns of Tuscany – Montepulciano, Pienza and Montalcino. From Florence, head south through the valleys and passing the many beautiful hill towns that have made this area so famous as you head towards the southern area of the Region to your first port of call – Montepulciano. Famous for its 'Vino Nobile di Montepulciano' – this medieval town is picturesque, quaint, extremely interesting to visit and explore and tasting the famous Wine of Montepulciano is a must.

Before arriving at Montepulciano, like the other towns to be visited your local expert Driver will give you a brilliant introduction on the area, the town, what to see, enjoy and explore, its people, history, culture and products allowing you to make the most out of your time.



From Montepulciano you will head to Pienza located high on one of Tuscany's hillsides both the views arriving here and the views from the town itself are unforgettable. The town itself is quite small and easily visited and enjoyed although as your local expert Driver will tell you, it's difficult to tear yourself away from these views and enjoy the town. For cheese lovers you should taste the Pecorino cheese which is a speciality of Pienza.

Montalcino, which is a great wine town, is our final stop before returning North to Florence. This particular town is known for the 'Brunello di Montalcino' – another fine red Tuscan wine. Just as beautiful as the town of Montepulciano, Montalcino also has those picture postcard views to enjoy as well as the beautiful quaint corners of the town itself. (tour duration: 10 hours)



We'll walk to the palatine hill to visit the ruins of the imperial palaces and its small museum. We then head to the Basilica of St. Peter in Chains to see the Holy Chains of St. Peter and the Moses carved by Michelangelo!!! Not to mention the Vittoriano (otherwise known as the Wedding Cake).

The tour ends with a panoramic drive past Circus Maximus, Aventino Hill and the Palatino Hill. (tour duration: 4 hours)

One of the most characteristic features of Positano is the architecture of the houses: cubes, painted white, pink, red, orange, almost all with a small porch in front, some with



a spherical dome. The entire built up area is surrounded by green palm and citrus groves, which makes it particularly delightful.



The Town of Sorrento began its career back at the beginning of the 19th century when Naples began to grow too piquant for English tastes. Sorrento's secret is a certain perfect cosiness, comfortable like old shoes or a favourite cardigan. It certainly helps that Sorrento is a lovely, civilized old town. Not many resorts can trace their ancestry back to the Etruscans or claim a native son like the poet Torquato Tasso. (tour duration 10 h)

The Gallery is located just a few minutes walking from the Via Veneto. The visit of the villa/museum lasts approx. 2 hours followed by a pleasant walk in the beautiful Borghese Gardens. (tour duration: 3 hours)

- A private art tour is a unique experience you will never forget. With an entire gallery at your disposal, a private guide will help you appreciate the most important treasures before you. Enjoy the opportunity to arrange exclusive private tours of the Vasarian Corridor, the Accademia Gallery and the Uffizi Gallery.
- Along the Arno River above the Ponte Vecchio, between the Palazzo Vecchio and Palazzo Pitti sits the Vasarian Corridor, a passageway commissioned from Giorgio Vasari by Cosimo I to celebrate his son's marriage. Over 700 paintings of the 17th and 18th



centuries, as well as an impressive collection of self-portraits from master painters, grace this unique Florentine gallery that features magnificent views of the city.

- Enjoy an incredible private tour of the Accademia dell'Arte gallery, renowned for its collection of sculptures by Michelangelo, including "The Prisoners," "St. Mathew" and, most importantly, the original statue of "David." Transferred from the Piazza della Signoria in 1873 to a specially designed tribune, marvel at this masterpiece in utter privacy.
- Visit the magnificent Uffizi gallery in a special and exclusive private tour. You and your
